2020 Dick Janas Scholarship

Purpose: To assist high school seniors, high school graduates, people who have obtained a GED or other high school equivalence degrees and students at a two to four-year accredited college or university who are continuing their education in pursuit of a degree.

The following definitions will be used for this application.

Qualified Associate Member shall be an Associate Member who at the time of submitting the application is an Associate Member in good standings with the North Carolina Association of Agricultural Fairs (NCAOAF), and who has been an Associate Member of the NCAOAF for at least 3 of the past 4 calendar years.

Qualified Applicant shall be an Associate Member, spouse, children or grandchildren (biological, stepchildren or adopted).

Associate Information:

1. Make as many copies of the application as you need.
2. Each qualified Associate Member can submit **ONE** application each year to the Dick Janas Scholarship Committee.
3. The qualified Associate Member must sign all applications and be sure that the required materials such as grade transcripts, standardized test results, etc., are included with the application. If the applicant was home schooled or attended any other school that did not use a transcript system, a Xerox copy of their SAT, ACT, or any other standardized test scores should be attached.
4. The qualified Associate Member shall **mail** the completed application by May 11, 2020 to the **Executive Director** of the NCAOAF, PO Box 58220, Raleigh, NC 27658. The **Executive Director** shall certify that the Associate Member is a **Qualified Associate Member** before the application is forwarded to the Scholarship Committee.

Purpose: To assist high school seniors, high school graduates, people who have obtained a GED or other high school equivalent degree and students at a two to four-year accredited college or university who are continuing their education in pursuit of a degree.

Awards: As this is an Endowment funded scholarship, the award will be determined by the returns of the proceeds. However, **no person who plans to or who is enrolled in a four-year institution shall receive more than \$2400 over their lifetime from the Dick Janas Scholarship Fund and no person who plans to or who is enrolled in a two-year institution shall receive more than \$1200 over their lifetime from the Dick Janas Scholarship Fund.** If the applicant is awarded a sum smaller than the maximum mentioned above, he or she may apply again the following year or years until the maximum amount has been received, so long as the applicant remains qualified.

Applicant Rules:

1. Applicants must be a senior or a graduate of a public high school, private high school, home school or equivalent (persons who have received a GED). Applicants may also be attending a two to four-year accredited college or university.
2. Completed applications must be submitted along with supporting documents to the sponsoring Associate Member on a date to be determined by the sponsoring member.
3. All questions on the application form must be answered.
4. Grade transcripts are required with all applications. If you were home schooled or attended any school that did not use a transcript system, a Xerox copy of your SAT, ACT, or any other standardized test you have taken should be attached.
5. Applicant must take enough class hours to be considered a full-time student to receive the Dick Janas Scholarship.
6. Awards will be made through the Financial Aid Office of the university or college. These funds must be credited directly toward tuition, fees, or books.
7. Scholarship recipients must maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative grade points average. If the required grade point average is not maintained; scholarship funds will be withheld. However, the funds can be reinstated if the grade point average is attained at the end of the term for which the funds were withheld.
8. If a student withdraws from college, and a refund is due, it shall be returned to the NCAOAF Dick Janas Scholarship Fund.
9. If awarded a scholarship, the student must be enrolled in college before one calendar year passes or they forfeit their scholarship. If awarded a \$2400 scholarship and recipient decides to attend a two-year college or university, the award will be reduced to \$1200. If awarded a \$1200 Scholarship to attend a two-year college or university, and the student completes the two-year course and decides to go to a four-year college or university they may reapply for an additional \$1200 scholarship.
10. Two letters of recommendation other than one from the nominating associate member will be the maximum allowed. However, letters of recommendations are not required.
11. All information on this application should be **typed or printed**, except where signature is required.
12. Conduct which occurs, which is deemed unacceptable for scholarship development will be grounds for withdrawing the NCAOAF Dick Janas Scholarship Award.

IN SELECTING WHO SHOULD RECEIVE THE DICK JANAS SCHOLARSHIP, THE COMMITTEE SHALL LOOK AT AN APPLICANTS SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENTS AS WELL AS ANY FINANCIAL HARDSHIP AND OTHER SPECIAL CHALLENGES ABOUT THE APPLICANT.
